2016 - Blanco de Viura - Las Planas - Rioja, Spain A hugely characterful wine with rich honeyed stone fruit, melon & quince aromas. Two years in oak provides well integrated, silky buttery & toasty vanilla notes. One of only 50 wines in the world to win the prestigious 'Best in Show' Decanter award in 2021.		<b>£97</b>
2020 - Pouilly-Fuisse 1er Cru - Bourcier Martinot - Mâconnais, Burgundy, France Vibrant and zippy with a superb structure, delicate minerality and a long finish. Ripe citrus and stone fruits are underpinned by fine saline, stony flavours and a well integrated hint of oak. This is a top class Burgundy with wonderful complexity.		<b>£118</b>
2019 - Chassagne -Montrachet - Domaine Coffinet-Duvernay - Côte de Beaune, France Elegantly toasty with peach and apple fruit, white flowers and a little spice. Fresh and finely balanced. 2021 - Catarratto - Fabrizio Vella - Sicily, Italy	<b>£9.5</b>	<b>£47</b>
A natural wine with an abundance of character, opulent texture, crisp green apple and citrus nose and a lemon drizzle cake finish. Authentically Sicilian, this is a great introduction to the world of skin contact wines.		
2021 - Alta Alella 'Aus' - Alella - Catalunya, Spain		<b>£67</b>
Golden amber, wild and fresh with hints of fennel and tangerine peel. Indigenous Pansa Blanca grapes are fermented in Amphora, made of clay from the organic, biodynamic vineyard within Serralada de Marina Natural Park. The family run vineyard is committed to nature and vested in bird preservation too. The label certainly shows the story of this wine.

Vibrant and light bodied yet full of flavour. Bright red berry aromas with hints of wild thyme and a juicy palate of cherry, raspberry and liquorice. Silky with smooth tannins and a great length of flavour.		
2020 - Pinot Noir - Presqu'île - Santa Barbara, USA		<b>£66</b>
Made using traditional, natural winemaking techniques this wine is gorgeous and beautifully balanced. Oozing with juicy, ripe red fruit, it has notes of dried citrus, warm spice and earthy undertones. With only a touch of tannin it's a great red fish option.		
2017 - Clendenen 'The Pip' Nebbiolo - Santa Barbara, California, USA		<b>£80</b>
As a huge fan of Nebbiolo, traditionally found in Piedmont, Jim Clendenen produced a world-class crop in a tiny 1.63 acre vineyard in Santa Barbara. The resulting wine is deep and layered with flavours of plum, rose, apricot and blueberry and a subtle earthiness. It's rich but with a bright acidity and moderate tannins making it super versatile with food, even fish. Outstanding!		
2017 - Aloxe-Corton 'Les Valozieres' - Domaine Gerard Julien et Fils - Côte de Beaune, France		<b>£132</b>
With a juicy palate full of ripe summer fruits and herbal, earthy hints, this is a classic Burgundian Pinot Noir. Rich and structured but with lovely refined tannins on the finish, a little spice and a great balance of fruit and savoury flavours.		

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
